STEP I Application

Monday, February 1st – Wednesday, March 17th 9:00AM-3:00PM

Accepting applications for students for Grade 1-7. Copies of recent report cards and New York Standardized Tests results must be submitted along with the completed application forms.

STEP II Testing

A *testing fee of \$50.00 (non-refundable) will be collected on the following testing dates:

Friday, April 16 th	Grades 3-7	9:00AM-11:00AM
Friday, April 23 rd	Grade 1 & 2	9:00AM-11:00AM

STEP III Registration

Letters of acceptance will be sent during the week of April 26th 2010.

The Registration Form, Immunization Form, Technology Use Agreement, Media Authorization and Release Form and Board of Education Loan of Textbooks Permission Form will be enclosed. These forms, the amount of \$ 825.00 and a copy of your child's Birth Certificate, Social Security Card, Baptism Certificate(if Catholic) and immunization record must be returned by Monday, May 10th 2010.
