

2021 Transfiguration School Summer Institute

For students entering PreK-3 to Grade 7 (we added 7th grade!), the program is an exciting six weeks of inspirational learning developed to support bridging the learning pace over the last year and a half due to COVID, offer nurturing social environments in safe spaces and introduce new opportunities for specialized experiences. **As our currently enrolled families, you get first priority until April 5th to secure a seat in this program.** We strongly encourage families, especially families new to Transfiguration, to enroll their child(ren) in the program to provide meaningful experiences during the summer months.

IMPORTANT NOTES ABOUT THE 2021 SUMMER INSTITUTE

- In-Person and Virtual Options for PreK3, PreK4 and Kindergarten.
- Virtual Options for 1st - 7th Grades.
- Homework will be optional and provide an opportunity for students to practice the day's concepts but will not be mandatory.
- Grade Projects: Each grade will be given an exciting and challenging problem to solve for the summer. This project will be in class only with guidance by the teacher and full class participation. The goal is to provide the students with a thought provoking challenge to discuss and solve as a team. They will leave the summer feeling like an inventor, scientist, trailblazer and hero!
- PreK3, PreK4 and Kindergarten children will have full use of our private playground for lots of outdoor adventures and fresh air.
- We will have smaller class sizes (no more than 16 per class) in order to provide more customized and direct support for participating students.
- Full time academic year (Sept-June) students do not pay a registration fee for the summer.
- Due to the Archdiocese directives on air conditioning use, we are unable to provide cooling in two of our buildings. The comfort of the children and staff is important to be able to focus and learn. As a result of this mandate, we will be operating in person programs for PreK3, PreK4 and Kindergarten only at our Early Childhood campus. In addition to preparing that campus system to meet CDC guidance standards, we will also install air purifiers in each classroom.
- Uniforms are not required for the Summer Institute.

July 5 to August 13

Cost: \$2,100 per child; \$75 registration fee (*applied to non-Transfiguration students only*)

July 5 only: Special Schedule

Students with the last name from A - K, the program is from 9:00 AM to 11:30 AM.

Students with the last name from L - Z, the program is from 12:30 PM to 3:00 PM.

August 13 is a half day, dismissal by noon.

Incoming Kindergarten

July 5 to August 13

8:30 AM to 5:30 PM School Day

Cost: \$2,100 per child; \$75 registration fee (*applied to non-Transfiguration students only*)

Aug 13 is a half day with dismissal by noon.

Incoming Grades 1 to 7

July 5 to August 13

8:30 AM to 3:00 PM School Day

Cost: \$1,750 per child; \$75 registration fee (*applied to non-Transfiguration students only*)

August 13 is a half day, dismissal by noon.



Program costs, after school extension and registration fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.

Applications for Transfiguration School students will be accepted on a first come, first served basis through April 5, 2021. After that date, registration will be opened to the community.

A non-refundable deposit of \$300 is required upon registration to confirm a seat for your child in the program. Please reserve your seat and make your \$300 payment below. The balance will be due by May 14, 2021.
