Level 4 - Exceeds proficiency standard


Level 3 – Meets proficiency standard

Level 2 – Does not meet proficiency standard


Level 1 – Does not meet basic standard

ELA Proficiency Levels Across All Grades for 2018






How Transfiguration School Measures Up


Transfiguration School vs. NYC Math Proficiency Levels 2018
